- Breath-taking panoramic views of Amiens from the top of its towers.
- Discover the precious relic of the head of St Jean-Baptiste.

If you haven't already visited Amiens Cathedral, a jewel of Gothic architecture on a remarkable scale and boasting some impressive decor, then what are you waiting for?

Built in 1220 on the initiative of Bishop Evrard de Fouilloy and based on a design by architect Robert de Luzarches, the cathedral is now recognised as one of the largest Gothic churches in France. Notre-Dame d'Amiens, with its abundant decorative pieces, most of which are priceless thanks to their excellent state of repair, is a remarkable architectural feat that attracts visitors from all over the world. From the 13th-century bronze recumbent statues, miraculously spared during the French Revolution, to the 16th-century Flamboyant Gothic stalls, the cathedral is bursting with a thousand

masterpieces, not to mention the priceless relics of St John the Baptist and St Firmin, patron saint of the city of Amiens, to be found in the treasury room.

DID YOU KNOW...?

Amiens cathedral has twice been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, first in 1862 for its architecture and its rich decor, and again in 1998 as a monument along the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela.

Cathedral Towers: 2 p.m. / 2.45 p.m. / 3.30 p.m. / 4.15 p.m.
- Closed on Tuesdays and during religious ceremonies.
- Cathedral Treasury: 11 a.m. every day except on Tuesdays & Sundays / 2 p.m. every day except on Tuesdays.
- Closed on Tuesdays and during religious ceremonies.
- Closed on 1st January, 1st May, 25th December and the last Sunday of September.
